THE RIDE

Park at Kirkland Farm, Colvend ready to move off at 11 a.m. to Rockcliffe Beach through fields and woodland. At low tide cross the firth along the beach and return towards Kippford, back along the Jubilee footpath and into the forestry. Then proceed on to Kirkland Hill and back via the optional Cross Country course (with even more jumps than last year). The ride will take approximately 2 hours and lunch will be provided at £3 per head. A lead rein group will also be catered for.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All entrants MUST confirm on the entry form that they hold Third Party Liability insurance.
2. The organisers, landowners and tenants accept no liability for any death, loss, damage, injury or illness to horse, rider, owner, spectator or any other person or property whatsoever, whether by negligence, breach of contract or in any other way.
3. Riders are absolutely responsible for their own and their horse's equipment and for that of their children, if applicable.
4. As with hunting, if your horse kicks please tie a red ribbon in the tail. If it is a young horse please tie a green ribbon in the tail. Keep a safe and sensible distance from the horse in front of you at all times.

Points to Note:

- **There will not be any veterinary or medical cover, although basic First Aiders will be in attendance.**
- Riders should follow the directions of appointed stewards.
- Riders should avoid going backwards and forwards over a single jump.
- Riders in the jumping group must be willing to take fences at speed. Stewards reserve the right to move riders into another group if they are unsuited to their chosen group.
- Please choose your group carefully- pick and pop group will still be jumping but not at such a fast pace. Non jumpers will be best suited to the novice/young rider group.
- Entries will be accepted on the day for an extra £5 per person.
- **In order that the organisers can arrange group numbers and stewards, please indicate on the form which group you will be riding in; either the jumping group, the pick & pop group, the younger/novice or lead rein riders group.**
- The hunt fun rides organised by the DSFH are very like a typical days hunting. If you would like more information about hunting with us please see Hannah Hutchings on the day.
- There is no dress code, although entrants should wear safe and sensible riding clothes.
